About Natnael Ashebir

Natnael Ashebir (b. 1995, Ethiopia) is a multidisciplinary artist living and working in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia.

Ashebir's practice spans painting, drawing, and photography, critically engaging with themes of history, identity, memory, and belonging. He examines how individual and collective experiences shape the construction of self and place, crafting compelling visual narratives that merge personal reflection with broader sociocultural enquiry.

Ashebir's work offers a space for feeling, experiencing, and contemplating urbanisation—its significance in our time and its impact on life's many layers. He searches for beauty in imperfection, impermanence, and the incompleteness of a chaotic world. He balances spontaneity with deliberate compositions, assembling and juxtaposing elements that reflect the complexities of urban life.

His ongoing series, 'Layers of Life', which he describes as his "unorthodox archive," weaves together archival images and present-day experiences. Through his work, he captures the rhythm of time and space, layering form, colour, and texture to create intricate visual meditations.

Ashebir holds a BFA from the Alle School of Fine Art and Design (2021), a diploma from Entoto Polytechnic College (2016), and a certificate from Abyssinia Fine Art School (2013). In 2022, he was awarded second prize at the Emerging Painting Invitational (EPI) Prize. He has completed residencies at 32° East Ugandan Arts Trust, Kampala, Uganda (2023), and the AU20 Residency Program, Dakar, Senegal (2022).
