## **About Tim Leimbach**

Tim Leimbach (b. 1986, Wuppertal, Germany) is a visual artist living and working in Berlin. Initially trained in architecture at Bergische Universität Wuppertal, he went on to pursue a career as a drummer and songwriter before turning to painting in 2016. He studied Fine Arts at Universität der Künste Berlin in the class of Prof. Mark Lammert, where he graduated as a Meisterschüler in 2021.

Leimbach's practice explores the tension between figuration and abstraction. Figures often inhabit undefined, landscape-like spaces, where line, surface, and colour act as both disruptive and formative elements. His compositions carry a sense of unresolved narration, stories that begin to unfold but remain suspended, layered with different attempts at meaning. Drawing inspiration from everyday life, his paintings evolve through a process of spontaneous application, waiting, reconsideration, and constant alteration. This cyclical rhythm often pushes his works to the brink of disintegration, balancing fragility with intensity.

His work has been exhibited widely in Germany and internationally, including solo exhibitions at Galerie 1565, Hamburg, and Galerie K12, Berlin, as well as group presentations in Milan, Marseille, Gdańsk, and Santiago de Chile. Leimbach's paintings are held in the Streletzki permanent collection at ESTREL, Berlin, alongside numerous private collections.
