**Tashinga Majiri** (b. 1993, Harare, Zimbabwe) graduated in 2019 with a Diploma in Fine Art from the National Gallery of Zimbabwe school of Visual Art and Design, specializing in painting and printmaking.

Over the past couple of years, he has been working to develop his own approach which blends painting and printmaking together, working with monotypes on canvas interlaced with painting and spray paint.

As a poet he is also interested in the engagement that is possible through subtle incorporation of automatic writing in his canvases. His works float in and out of figuration and have the quality of daydreams, an escape from the here and now into art and its possibilities.

Recent exhibitions include *Green Shoots, Rembrandt at 350*, and *Masked*, all held at the National Gallery of Zimbabwe, as well as *Embodied Cognition* at THK Gallery.
